



NOTE: Every student on campus that weekend will participate in Prom. Our Prom is NOT the traditional prom. It is much more of a "formal" community party which includes all students, faculty, faculty families, and guests of students **if** they desire. Students may ask a date to the prom, but most do not have actual dates.

Guests:

- Must be of High School age [14 19] (Parent permission form received in advance) One guest per student
- Must be pre-approved through the Director of Student Services
- The guest is the responsibility of the student who extended the invitation and should be informed as to school rules and policies by that student.
- Guest may stay in provided & supervised accommodations on campus in a specially provided dorm (With satisfactory completed permission form received in advance of the prom)
- Guest's meal, post prom party, transportation, and overnight accommodations must be paid for by the student who has extended the invitation. The amount is **\$50** per guest payable to the Leelanau School in advance of the prom.

Girls:

Required

- Semi-formal dresses long or short (Hem length of dresses must reach the tips of the fingers when your arms are at your sides.) *No mini-dresses are acceptable.*
- Semi-formal pant suit
- Dress shoes/sandals

Optional

- Dressing to the theme is optional
- Hairstyling & Nails available off campus the evening before and the day of prom. (Depending upon services rendered, a range may be from **\$25 \$125**)
- Boutonniere for date (delivery on campus on day of event!) \$15 \$30

Boys:

Required

- Dress shirt and dress pants (ties are optional) Jeans are not acceptable.
- Dress Shoes
- Optional
- Dressing to the theme is optional
- Full suits
- Tuxedos (available at <u>The Captain's Quarters</u> in Traverse City 4 weeks before prom) \$109.99 \$159.99 depending on style. (This package includes coat, pant, shirt, vest, tie, and shoes, of their choice.) We will make a Tux Run for those wishing to go.
- Students renting Tuxedos must have parent permission to charge cost to PSA Please call Ms. Leo at (231-334-5801)
- Corsages for a date (available on campus florist off site) **\$15 \$35** depending on style & size.
- Haircuts (available off campus while on mall trip the week or night before prom) \$20 \$45 depending on length & style.
